

CONFLICT MINERALS Compliance Declaration

MUELLES CROM declares that the products it supplies do not contain any components commonly referred to as 'Conflict Minerals' in compliance with the Dodd-Frank Act of the United States.

"Conflict Minerals" is the term used to describe the following minerals: gold, wolframite, cassiterite, columbite-tantalite and their derivative metals, which include tin, tungsten and tantalum (collectively referred as 3TG) - no matter where they are mined or smelted - whose origin is from Democratic Republic of the Congo ("DRC") and adjoining countries. The adjoining countries are those that share an internationally recognized border with the DRC, presently: Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, the Republic of the Congo, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda and Zambia. This area is controlled by non-governmental military groups or illegal military factions that have contributed to the financing of armed conflict and human rights violations.

To ensure compliance with this regulation, **MUELLES CROM** has requested information from its suppliers regarding the use of conflict minerals. Based on the information provided by our supply chain, we can confirm that the products supplied by **MUELLES CROM** do not contain any of the metals from conflict zones.

On the other hand, the "Conflict Minerals" are not part of the components of the various materials used to manufacture our products, whose chemical composition is tabulated and standardized. Therefore, **MUELLES CROM** does not use any "Conflict Minerals" as components in our products, nor are they used during our manufacturing process.
